The Association for Orphans of the Guardia Civil (Spain) extends an invitation to the countries of the European Gendarmerie Force (EUROGENDFOR) to participate in the second edition of the international language course in English and Spanish.

This program aims to give the designated beneficiaries the opportunity to acquire values of coexistence, respect for oneself, others and the environment, collaboration, cooperation and solidarity, as well as to enable interpersonal relationships between young people of different nationalities, all of which will contribute to facilitating their future integration into the world of work.

➤ **Beneficiaries. Young people (preferably orphans) from the Social Services of:**

➤ **Course Details**

- Full board Accommodation in a residence.
- Rooms with ensuite bathrooms.
- One bilingual instructor for every 6-8 students.
- One bilingual coordinator.
- 100/80 hours of instruction in the chosen language. Recreational and sports activities.
- At the end of the course, all participants will receive a certificate of attendance.
- Materials included for all activities.
- Course provider: Dundee School of English <https://dundeeschool.com/>.



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➤ **Requirements:**

- Age: 18 to 24 years old, preferably orphans.
- Language level: Minimum B1 level in the chosen language, intermediate level of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).
- In the event of a tie or more applicants than available places, priority will be given to the youngest applicant.

- **Places:** The total number of places offered is a maximum of 42 beneficiaries, according to the following distribution for each course modality:

A) **English Course**



- 14 places for orphans of the APHGC (Spain)
- 2 places for Portugal.
- 2 places for France.
- 2 places for Italy.
- 2 places for Romania.
- 2 places for Lithuania.
- 2 places for Ukraine.
- 2 places for the Netherlands.
- 2 places for Poland.

B) **Spanish course**



- 2 places for Portugal.
- 2 places for France.

➤ **List participants**

The Social Services of the Gendarmeries of Portugal, France, Italy, Romania, the Netherlands, Poland, Lithuania and the Gendarmerie-National Police of Ukraine will submit, before May 15, 2026, the list of successful applicants according to the number of places assigned, as well as the reserve list.

➤ **Cost of courses**

Tuition, accommodation, and meals: free. Language courses, accommodation, meals, travel, teachers and instructors, recreational and sports activities, etc., **are funded by the APHGC's 2026 budget.**

The participant, and, where applicable, their affiliated institution, will only be responsible for their personal expenses and travel to and from the APHGC headquarters.

Insurance: During the courses, participants will be covered by liability and accident insurance. However, students must bring their European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) to the course, and if applicable, their public or private health insurance card, as well as their identity document.

➤ **Resignation, non-appearance or abandonment of the course**

Express acceptance of the granted course implies a commitment to participate in it except for cases of force majeure documented before the related Institution (events “unforeseeable and unavoidable” such as illnesses or accidents).

➤ **Conditions of accommodation and stay**

- a) Students may arrive at the venue on the afternoon of July 1st, 2026, and stay until the morning of July 11 th, 2026.
- b. Accommodation is provided in single rooms with full board. If, due to unforeseen circumstances, accommodation has to be arranged in one of the Association's social welfare residences, it will be in double rooms.
- c. The course is residential. Students are required to stay overnight in their assigned accommodation.
- d. Students are also required to have breakfast, lunch, and dinner daily in the university dining hall, as interaction among students during these meals is part of the academic language immersion program.
- e. No student will be admitted to the course after 8:30 a.m. on July 2, the date on which the course will begin, except for duly documented cases of force majeure that will be assessed by the Academic Management and, as far as possible, must be requested and authorized in advance.

➤ **General conditions of attendance**

Attendance at all scheduled course activities is mandatory. Failure to do so will result in the student being required to leave the course and accommodation immediately, and will be subject to the terms and conditions outlined in the course admission document.



➤ **Academic and activities program**

Prior to the start of the course, students will receive the program designed by the academic institution.

This will include some sociocultural activities that complement the academic programs, such as:

- Visits to the city of Madrid (Real Madrid Tour, Retiro Park, Royal Palace, Prado Museum, Gran Vía, Rastro flea market, etc.).
- Visits to Civil Guard facilities (Civil Guard canine unit, exhibition on the evolution and equipment of the Guardia Civil TEDAX (Explosive Ordnance Service) unit, etc.
- Lectures/discussions on current affairs.
- ExtraTalkTime (individual conversation sessions).
- Games/theatre.

➤ **Student behavior regulations**

- a. Participants in the Language Immersion Course are required to attend all course activities punctually and must inform the APHGC of any incidents that occur during the course.
- b. Participants' involvement in the activities is subject to the course organizers' decisions.
- c. Once the daily scheduled activities have concluded, participants must remain on the Association premises (Infanta Campus) unless, in exceptional circumstances, the course organizers expressly authorize their departure.

The place allocation document will specify the particular circumstances regarding the student's behavior regulations and the cancellation policy.
